Synopsis of Board Meeting 18 March 2014

The meeting was called to order at 6:56 by Paul Lee.

The minutes from the February meeting were read and approved.

The treasurer reported income for the past month was \$3,957.37, of this amount \$2,215.00 was contributed to the Building Fund. Giving to the General Fund was \$1,732.81. This resulted in a deficit of \$644.82. The treasurer's report was approved.

The VP of Programs reports that she is working on the programs for May. She noted that more service leaders are needed. Chris Rohrs and Dave Walker volunteered to be fill-in service leaders.

The Congregational Care Committee submitted a report about recent contacts.

It was reported that \$167 was collected for Alterna House in LaGrange.

Harry Underwood gave a presentation to the Board about youth initiatives that the Fellowship could develop to attract and keep younger members. Chris Rohrs will work with Harry to develop an action plan to implement possible initiatives.

Administrative Report was reviewed.

The General Assembly is coming up in June in Rhode Island. The Board determined that our congregation participate by voting on issues as we are notified and by reviewing the reports from UUA committees and meetings.

It was suggested that a PayPal account link be added to our Facebook page and website. Connie will investigate the cost of adding such a feature.
