## Synopsis of Board Meeting-21 January, 2013

The meeting was called to order by Paul Lee. New Board members were welcomed.

The minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed and approved.

The Treasurer reported that income for the month of December was \$8,192.09 and expenses were \$2,986.87. Of this amount \$4,262.00 were donations to the building fund. Total income for the year was \$44,855.54 with expenses totaling \$30,496.82.

It was reported that new French doors would be installed on January 23. The old doors were rotting and needed to be replaced.

Michelle Midgette reported that plans for programs for the upcoming year were on target. She reported that all months had coordinators except for May and December.

There was a discussion about what Service Leaders needed to do when it seemed that a speaker's time might be abbreviated because of lengthy preliminary activities. She reported that she had sent an e-mail to Service Leaders highlighting an appropriate response in such a case.

Ed Wilson reported that Dash Morger would be joining the Fellowship.

The creation of a Building Fund Committee was tabled for further discussion.

The Fellowship collected \$342 for the Benevolent Fund on the January Third Sunday.

The Office Administrator's Report was reviewed.

The Time Line was reviewed and adjusted.

Board members volunteered for a month to call visitors and send out a thank you card to those visitors who requested contact.

There was a discussion about reviewing and revising the Fellowship Bylaws. It was suggested that this should be an agenda item for the next meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:14 PM.
