# Synopsis of Board Meeting—17 December 2013

Connie Ussery presented the minutes from the last meeting. The minutes were read and approved.

The treasurer's report was given. Nikki Rohrs reported that total income for November 2013 was \$5,288.58 and expenditures were \$3,668.72. She also reported that the Building Fund now totals \$58,000.92. She presented a proposed budget for the fiscal year 2014. The proposed budget was accepted.

Nikki gave a report on the cost to have the French doors replaced. The doors are rotting and need to be replaced. The estimate for replacement was \$1,235 which included installation. The speaker wires that are along the floor against the wall by the French doors need to be rerouted. The cost for rerouting the wires in the ceiling is \$455. It was unanimously voted to spend \$1690 to have the doors replaced and the electronic wires moved to the ceiling.

The Board determined that a Building Fund Committee was needed. It was decided that we establish parameters for its function at the next Board meeting.

The Children's program needs play equipment in the form of soccer balls, baseballs, bats, etc. The Board authorized Paul Lee to purchase play items for outside activities.

The Board reviewed the Administrator's Report and the Board Time Line.

It was suggested that several associations labeled as committees be abolished because their jobs have changed or merged into other offices or committees. The Finance Committee was relabeled as the Budget Committee.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:04 pm. The Board spent some time after the meeting decorating for the Christmas Party.
