I am writing you to request your support for the Homeless Resource Network of Columbus. You may have also recently received a request for support from the HRN director, Elizabeth Dillard. As chair of the fundraiser we have organized for March 21st at The Loft, I am sending you some additional information and adding my encouragement to you to support our extensive efforts in support of the Columbus population. Ours form a crucial set of support services not offered by shelters and other groups who specialize in medical and psychological counseling. Our office building on second avenue offers a storage facility that is the only place where a homeless individual can leave possessions for an extended period of time in a safe environment and have a mail address. We also specialize in helping people with local bus fare on a limited basis for essential trips such as for a medical check-up, or for obtaining a state ID card.
